

Paulo Pereira - Short Bio

Paulo de Carvalho Pereira graduated in Biochemistry in 1990 from the University of Coimbra and received his PhD in Cell Biology in 1996. Paulo obtained the title of Habilitation (Agregação) by the Faculty of Medicine University of Coimbra in 2007. Paulo Pereira worked at the Division of Clinical Toxicology, University College of London, during his PhD training and as a Post-Doc. Paulo subsequently worked as an Assistant Professor/Visiting Scientist at Human Nutrition Research Centre on Ageing at Tufts University, Boston, USA. In 2006 Paulo Pereira was granted A Fulbright Scholars and Researchers Program Award.

Paulo was director of the Centre of Ophthalmology and Vision Sciences at the university of Coimbra Director of the Laboratory for High-Resolution Cell Bio-imaging – University of Coimbra, Vice-director of the Faculty of Medicine University of Coimbra, Coordinator of Master course in Biomedical research and the Master in Vision Sciences. From 2011-2016 Paulo Pereira was vice-president of Portuguese Research Funding Organization FCT- Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia.
