An **ERC funded position of Lab manager** is currently open. We are seeking a highly motivated candidate to join our studies on metabolic regulation of cell fate and development. Applicants should ideally hold a PhD degree in a relevant subject area. Candidates should be organized, have experience with molecular biology and ideally with confocal imaging and *Drosophila* (not essential).

The position is initially funded for one year, with possibilities of extension.
